### **30 Act 48 PIL Hours**

Thirty (30) Act 48 PIL hours will be awarded to participants who complete this institute.

This two-day institute is designed to prepare superintendents, assistant superintendents, principals, and assistant principals to exercise strategic and systemic leadership in inspiring, mentoring, and mobilizing faculty and staff to address the learning needs of students with disabilities (SWD). Participants will design and develop continuous professional learning systems for school faculty and staff with a focus on supporting *ALL* students and considering inclusion approaches for students with disabilities.
